A 26-year old lady presented with a painful paramedian anterior neck mass. These are her ultrasound and CT scan images.

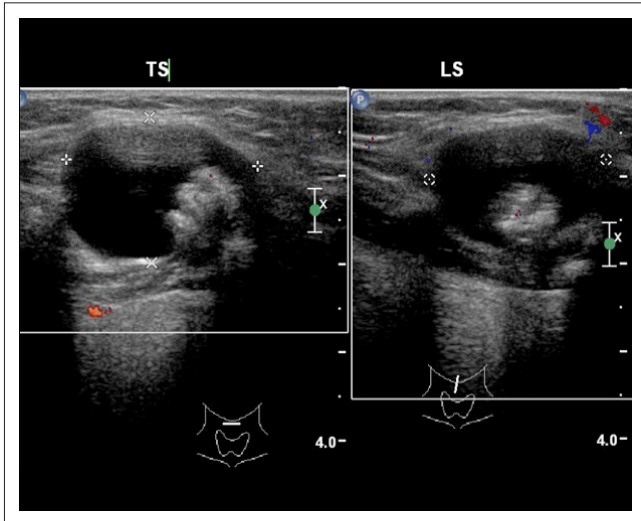


FIGURE 1: Sagittal B-mode sonar image.



FIGURE 2: Axial CT scan image at level of hyoid bone.

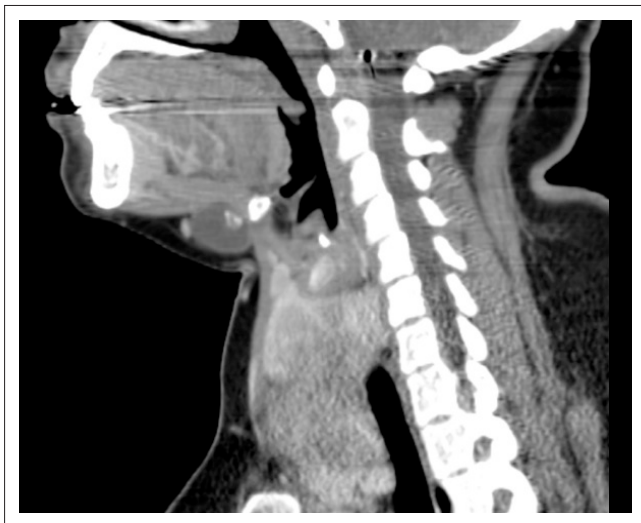


FIGURE 3: Sagittal paramidline CT scan image.
